ELEBRATING the remarkable and persevering efforts of the Malaysian real estate industry, the fifth StarProperty Awards 2022 Realtor Edition (SREA) welcomes a plethora of elite, outstanding agents and negotiators, all of whom overcame the adversity of the past year to bring the real estate industry to new heights.

Recognising not just the finest agencies, but also exemplary personal and professional development, the awards culminated in a night of glamorous enjoyment in Sheraton Petaling Jaya, Selangor, on 10 November. Set to the theme of The Great Gatsby, the awards saw old names and new in high spirits, talking and laughing the night away as their achievements were brought to the spotlight.

The event's Platinum Sponsor was Panasonic Malaysia, with Carlsberg Malaysia as its Official Beverage Partner and special thanks to OGAWA. In its mission to create a more

inclusive environment for the various actors of the real estate industry, allowing a fair and competitive chance for the crown, SREA 2022 returned with 23 categories and 31 sub-categories between agents and negotiators. Both groups were eligible for the All-Stars Award, Thriving Award, Rising Star Award, Developer Preferred Award, Developer Preferred Award (Bumiputra Lots), Subsale Award, Regional Award, Best Digital Marketing Award and StarProperty Readers' Choice.

#### > 2017

The first StarProperty Awards Realtor Edition was held at Connexion @ Nexus Bangsar South on Aug 8. With six categories in total, the awards acknowledged the nation's real estate agencies, agents and negotiators, highlighting their topquality services.

#### > 2018

The second StarProperty Awards Realtor Edition was held in grand style at the New World Hotel, on Oct 10, in honour of well-deserving negotiators and agencies. The awards introduced four new categories that included the opportunity for the public to vote for their preferred real estate negotiator and agency. The total number of categories was 14.

HE fifth StarProperty Awards 2022 Realtor Edition (SREA) rewarded the perseverance and development of Malaysia's real estate agents and negotiators in the aftermath of the Covid-19 pandemic. Welcoming five judges selected meticulously for their background and expertise, SREA 2022 saw 23 categories and 31 sub-categories, awarding a total of 87 recipients.

For a thorough and holistic judging process, the award categories were divided between agencies and negotiators. With a judging process that emphasised performance and development, judges followed a rigorous, fair and transparent procedure that truly awarded high-quality agencies and negotiators within the Malaysian real estate industry.

chairman Lee Han Rick Here's what they had to say about the awards this year:

"The Real Estate Awards is an excellent recognition for an important role in the industry to complement the developers' internal marketing and sales of both the primary and sub-sale markets. The industry needs healthy sales to support a large economy whilst providing job opportunities to all levels of skills," OSK Property's Lim said.

He pointed to the fact that the participants demonstrated a maturing level of skillsets, approach and sophistication in the industry, leading to a high level of professionalism that the market will come to accept and respect.

#### **New generation**

When it comes to the new generation of agents and negotiators, this matured and sophisticated approach has also been noted by Simon.

"To my delight, we have many outstanding young agents, in particular the female, believing in professionalism and willing to share their experience and helping others to help themselves. Their entrepreneurship and ability to innovate and adapt to changing market environments, in particular during the pandemic by using social media and technology, are encouraging and a sign of potential and sustainable growth in this profession," Simon said.

Lim pointed to the large adoption and advancement of the digital age by the participants, embracing more efficient methods such as creative digital marketing and digitalisation of processes to do better.

These aspects of real estate would further appeal to a younger purchaser audience, which was an important part of the market. Gamuda Land's Tan also emphasised on the timeliness of the awards.

"The Covid-19 pandemic has impacted

everyone, although perhaps some, in varying degrees. For some, it has also opened opportunities. As such, it was heartening to listen to the various stories shared by the participants who not just adapted to the new normal but pivoted their business and have proven themselves to be resilient in the face of adversity," Tan said.

She noted the various stories from realtors who had to grapple with health issues and overcome obstacles, yet continued their determination to succeed and turned their adversities into stepping stones towards a better quality of life.

This hopeful outlook was repeated by Rehda Youth chairman Lee Han Rick.

"I was particularly moved by some of their testimonies of how entering this industry changed the trajectory of their lives through the financial freedom it offered them and the opportunity for personal growth and development. I have no doubts that all the participants from this year will go on to have rewarding careers and play their role in elevating the real estate industry," Lee said.

#### Industry trends

When it came to emerging trends, Simon applauded the strong up-and-coming young teams competing with the bigger, established names in the primary market.

"An indication that the young people are tapping into their own potential and working together to create and share the bounty. It is interesting to note that the sub-sale and rental sectors are doing equally well and this will serve the homeowners well in their dealings," he said.

"The interesting trend is that coming out of the pandemic, there are fewer primary launches and therefore a more active subsale market. The lower entry price of the subsale market also makes it more competitive besides the exemption of RPGT (Real Property Gains Tax) by the government," Lim said.

Speaking as a spokesperson for Bank Rakyat, mortgage financing head Haslina Ali similarly shared that the bank saw a positive trend in this year's StarProperty Real Estate Awards, especially when it came to the subsale sector. "The sub-sale sector still plays an important role and continues to be the one with a massive portfolio. Interestingly, the rental sector is seeing an uptrend and creates an opportunity for participants to further explore and venture into this sector in a structured way by linking (meet and greet) the owners for the tenants, and vice versa and ensuring the transactions are carried out compliantly," she said.

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In buyer sentiment, Tan saw a shift in purchaser reasoning, from property as an investment to property as a living space.

"As a property developer, we are starting to notice buyer movement panning towards choosing a property for own occupation versus for speculative investment in the primary market. We also see a preference towards landed and low-density developments with larger and more spacious layouts that come with an extra room or study post-pandemic, for the family," she said.

#### Into the future and beyond

"Real estate agents (REA) will always have an important role in the industry as the REA captures a wider market and are more agile to embrace, train and use the latest marketing and selling techniques. I am also pleased to see that the REA are raising the bar in their approach as a more professional and progressive organisation," Lim said.

Stressing the growing empowerment of female agents and negotiators, Simon pointed out that the SREA 2022 greatly helped to recognize gender equality in the industry.

"I will suggest that their related associations petition the authorities to reduce the administrative process in the registration of transfer, charge, application for consent to transfer and charge to bring down the time required to complete the transaction which will increase their profits. Application of blockchain technology will also increase the trust needed in this industry," he added.

With the change coming into the industry, Tan pointed to sustainability and digitalisation agendas as paramount, adding that those with long-term sustainable plans and digital innovations will remain longer as top players in the industry.

"This is a reflection of the real estate industry in general as moving forward, the focus among stakeholders will be on the environmental, social and governance agenda. Industry players that shift to embrace and walk the talk in these areas will solidify the position at the perch," she said.

"We are also seeing more interest in vibrant placemaking that strengthens the connection between communities and the places they share. It facilitates a town's creative patterns of use, paying particular attention to physical, cultural and social characteristics that define a place," she added.

"Nevertheless, we still need the primary sector to continue offering potential buyers the updated or latest models while making it more affordable and sustainable," Haslina said on behalf of Bank Rakyat.

"Looking at the endemic situation, the house price plays a vital role in the decisionmaking process. Affordable, according to each income segment, B40, M40 and T20, with sustainable elements will be the attractive selling points for buyers to consider. We are also seeing more active support coming from Federal and State governments within the affordable segment especially," she added. **3**  **AWARD FEATURE**

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# Why join the real estate sector?

The sky is the limit when it comes to success in real estate

ITH property always in high demand, the real estate sector sees no shortage of work. Agents and negotiators deal not just in the buying and selling of properties but also in human relationships and connections.

According to Maxland Real Estate Agency probationary estate agent Royston Lau, the benefits of the real estate sector are abundant. It is a business that can generate good revenue with low capital investment, unlike other businesses where you need to have an office or retail space for daily operations, which may incur renovation costs, rental, staff wages and other expenses.

"Besides being a sales representative earning for living, we also able to understand the property market better and benefit in our own property investment too," Foreward Realty project director Lim Kak Yi said.

According to Firdaus & Associates Group of Companies founder and group managing director Datuk Firdaus Musa, being part of the real estate agency business opens up a plethora of knowledge, networking, marketing, sales, teamwork, training and commitment with the sole purpose of assisting purchasers or tenants in achieving their property goals and to render the best service to the sellers or landlords in disposing or renting the property

With that, Lim noted that the most attractive part of the real estate sector is that results are measurable. The amount of effort put into the work is the amount of results returned.

"Be-your-own-boss for me is that I can plan my routine based on my pace, be it faster or slower as long as I achieve the target that I set for myself. Meanwhile, be-your-own-boss sounds nice, but we need to have good discipline and be eager to succeed in this sector," Lim cautioned.

The business of the real estate sector allows its workers to participate in wealth generation, capital appreciation and revenue income investment as compared to other income generation in terms of



shares or business, Firdaus said. "Anytime is a good time to start. There are always buyers in the market, it is just a matter of the right price depending on the demand of the particular property," Lau said.

Joining the real estate sector had not initially been Lau's goal. He never knew the real estate business was such a lucrative option until he saw a friend making good money in the sector. At the same time, he had been encouraged by a friend to attend a recruitment talk organised by a real estate firm to understand more about the business. He joined right after listening.

"[You] get to know all levels of people, you may get to work with a company CEO (chief executive officer), a celebrity," Lau said.

For Firdaus, he had known he wanted to be an agent ever since he was introduced to his father's friend, a broker selling houses in Johor Bahru. Watching his demeanour and how he approached buyers in convincing a good purchase is what drove Firdaus into the real estate sector, particularly in agency work.

He enrolled to further his studies in Urban Real Estate Management at Kingston University, United Kingdom, worked in a property consultancy firm, earned his registration with the Board and set up Firdaus & Associates Property **Professionals** 

"In the real estate agency work, in the earlier years, what surprised me was with a bit of knowledge, some basic strategy, I could close a deal within a month or less and I would suddenly earn more than my other fixed salaried friends. It was all dependent on that little effort put in and even if there were no efforts, I was then paid a salary which was decent," Firdaus said.

"There was no ambition in earning a

huge sum of money as I was comfortable as I was. Now, It's a fast-growing industry with everyone jumping into the bandwagon to earn more than the extra income earned. And the real estate agency people are a different kind of animal in terms of networking, aggressiveness in marketing and sales, exposure and knowledge, the sophistication in the real estate process from the A to Z and the work hard play hard lifestyle of these new gens," he added.

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The sky was the limit with real estate agents, Lau agreed.

However, with the benefits of flexible working hours, came the need for selfdiscipline and hard work, to ensure that agents do not become lazy and complacent.

Agents must be able to work independently, especially in sub-sales. Most of the time, a listing will be handled by an individual agent, the agent must take the initiative to plan and market the property effectively.

The reality of the market was that not all the property can be sold in a short period of time, Lau noted that the agent must have the persistence to continue to market the property until it is closed.

"The person must be able to work full time and be able to perform the viewing at any reasonable time, no part-time agent will be successful in this sector," he said.

"Spend more time communicating with clients to obtain good listing and close the deal at the appropriate time rather than always attending unnecessary motivation classes or keep providing info to clients which couldn't transform into a deal closing," he added. 😚

# The future is looking bright

After two years of volatility, the market is bouncing back

TAKEHOLDERS of the real estate industry are looking towards 2023 with high expectations. While there are still many factors that could still create issues like political uncertainty, increasing interest rates and the rising cost of materials and services which will impact buyers and renters, the fact that there is a steady rise in demand for property equates to good news.

The existing stocks and properties that were recently launched will help to stabilise the prices of real estate for the short term. This gives investors, buyers and tenants a short period to lock down the prices.

Chester Group of Companies chairman and chief executive officer Kam Jun Yin said 2022 has been a turbulent time for those in the real estate sector and the uncertainties have deterred many potential buyers from making their purchases.

However, those who have job stability and steady income have begun to look for good bargains in the market during this period as this is also the best time to buy, he said.

Property developers are also feeling more optimistic about next year's outlook.

more optimistic about next year's outlook. "Developers such as Sime Darby Property and

SuezCap are some of the clients that we have a positive relationship with, and they have signed us on for several on-going and even upcoming projects. We see 2023 as a positive year. With GE settling down and the new budget favouring the property industry, we believe the market will be more stable in the coming year.

"Also, many of our clients have hinted that they are gearing up for launches in 2023. Moreover, with inflation going up, we see many investors switching to property to safeguard their wealth and hedge against currency depreciation," said Foreward Realty chief executive officer Steve Yap.

Juwai IQI group managing director Daniel Ho revealed that the group's overall revenue growth for the year 2022 compared to 2021 has risen by 60%.

"We expect to achieve a total revenue of RM470 million by the end of 2022. These phenomenal achievements are attributed to our technological advancement that empowers our agents to be more efficient in the marketplace, as well as our extensive global platform with more than 700 primary projects making IQI the agency with the most projects in the Asia Pacific region. By onboarding to the IQI Ecosystem, agents can five times to 10 times their business. We are undoubtedly optimistic that 2023 will be a record-breaking year for us," he added.

However, Tech Realtors Properties brand associate director Barry Ong said the real estate's performance in 2023 will depend on several factors like the finalisation of the 2023 Budget, Malaysia's depreciating ringgit and interest hikes and the inflation rate.

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# A lofty but attainable goal

# Forging ahead in challenging times

Hurdles also create opportunities for real estate industry stakeholders

HE recent Covid-19 pandemic posed a great challenge for many industries, including the real estate industry in Malaysia. But it is not the only challenge. The subsequent reverberating effects from this root cause have triggered off other issues. But not everything is all doom and gloom.

Thankfully, 2022 has performed relatively much better than the previous year, said The Roof Realty Sdn Bhd real estate agent Ivan Chong.

"The Roof Realty, being the largest subsale agency in the market, has seen rapid growth in the industry this year compared to the previous year. The mass market has been actively sorting for properties after a long pandemic.

"Many foreigners are flocking into Malaysia for business purposes, hence increasing property ownership by them. It is due to our multi-cultural diversity which attracts FDI (foreign direct investment) influx into the country. In addition, support and incentives given by the government also increased property ownership among locals. All these have contributed to a better real estate market in 2022," he said.

No doubt that the unpredictable market environments of pre, current and post covid-19 pose new opportunities. "As tenants and buyers have to adjust their business strategy to adapt and survive, we too will need to assist landlords in adjusting our marketing efforts in order to fit into what the market need, that includes the methods we employ to attract interest, to conduct property inspections, and complete the documentation needed to conclude an offer and acceptance.

"For example, physical viewing to inspect the property has always been the gold standard pre-pandemic. During the covid-19, inspections using video calls were employed although many struggled to decide on such methods. Some accepted this as a solution, hence making it easier for them to accept that agents can witness the signing of a confirmation of sale document via a video call. The legality of this method can always be challenged, however as long as both parties honour what has been agreed and proceed to the next step and execute the deal, it is done," said Tech Realtors Properties team leaders and senior negotiator Kevin Kho.

sentiment among property buyers, and lower disposable income may slow decisionmaking among the buyers. However, I am confident that developers and estate agencies will come out with different packages and stimulating factors to overcome it," said WEREG Properties chief executive officer Ethan Leong.

Another challenge, particularly for real estate agencies in Malaysia, would have been managing human resources. I can foresee a drop in professionalism due to pointless recruitment policies and lower entry of the agent or negotiator. It could jeopardise the professional quality of the agents or negotiators in the market, and many agencies need to look into that and not just focus on profit-making only. However, they could have done this better with training facilities and human resources management.

Overall, Chester Properties director Patrick Yong believes that the economy is transforming and the real estate market is recovering.
